Eligibility

Eligibility for this scholarship is limited to participants presently in the *Company Program – A Student Venture – in school and after school programs.* To be considered for a scholarship under current selection procedures, a candidate must:

- 1. Be a senior student who will be graduating in the 2005/06 academic year.
- 2. Enrol in a Canadian University, College or Technical Institute commencing September 2006.
- 3. Have two letters of recommendation (in sealed envelopes and signed across the flaps by the authors of the letters) one from a Teacher and the other from your Student Venture Program Advisors.
- 4. Be actively involved in one or more community or school organizations.
- 5. Deliver their application, accompanied by the required supporting documents, to Junior Achievement of Southern Alberta, 870 1202 Centre St. S.E., Calgary, AB, T2G 5A5 **on or before JANUARY 31, 2006.**

Basis for Determining the Scholarship Winner

All Applicants are required to submit a fully completed application form, including an official high school transcript for at least the last two years. (If a transcript is not available, a mid-year report will suffice.).

The scholarship winner is selected on the basis of participating in the *Company Program* - *A Student Venture*, scholastic ability and other available information, which indicates achievement, leadership, and career potential.

A panel of JASA Board Directors will interview short-listed candidates.

The scholarship winner will be announced at the **Celebration of Achievement** in 2006.

Amount of Scholarship

This scholarship provides for the payment of \$2,500 to the winner. Upon presentation of proof of enrolment in the qualifying post-secondary institution, a cheque will be sent to the education institution. The following conditions apply to the scholarship:

- The scholarship can only be applied against recipient's tuition after the deadline for dropping classes has passed;
- If the tuition is less than \$2,500, the balance of the scholarship should be applied to the next semester's tuition; and
- If the recipient does not attend the next semester, the balance of the scholarship must be refunded to Junior Achievement of Southern Alberta.

The scholarship is a one-time grant; it is not renewable, nor will past winners be eligible to reapply.

Junior Achievement of Southern Alberta reserves the right to modify the scholarship, in whole or in part, at any time.
